History

SONOMA was a 6279 ton passenger liner built by W. Cramptons Co. in Philadelphia in 1900. It operated for the Oceanic Steam Ship Company, which became a subsidiary of the Matson Line in 1926, travelling between San Francisco and Sydney making stops at Honolulu and Auckland. The vessel was scrapped in 1934.
